Youth Capacity-Building Training & Model APEC











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To cultivate international communication professionals and promote understanding of the APEC operation, IIED, Taipei Tech, and the Chinese Taipei's Ministry of Education jointly organized the "2023 APEC Youth Capacity-Building Training & Model APEC" from July 6th to 7th. The event had expanded invitation to overseas students this year, attracting 22 students from 13 APEC economies to participate along with 40 domestic students from prestigious universities and high schools. The participants were able to exchange ideas, discuss regional affairs, and broaden their international perspectives through the event. This years marks the fifth year of the APEC youth training program and model APEC, with a cumulative total of 320 students participating over the years.

The aim of this event is to help young people both domestically and internationally to gain a deeper understanding of APEC issues, learn how to voice their opinions on the international stage, and understand the operating rules of international meetings. Ultimately, these young participants will become a driving force of the APEC region.
